NO BERLIN ANNOUNCE NEW SINGLE “FLOW” — OUT JANUARY 15, 2026 VIA QUASI POP

Berlin-based power pop and alternative rock band **No Berlin** return with “Flow”, the first single from their upcoming EP *Maybe I Should Figure Out Why I’m So Angry All the Time*, out spring 2026 on **Quasi Pop**. The track captures the awkward moments of self-realization, revealing that sometimes the discomfort we feel isn’t caused by others—but by ourselves.

Recorded with the band’s signature mix of catchy melodies and introspective energy, *Flow* marks a bold new chapter for No Berlin. The song’s narrative of self-reflection pairs with an angrier, more contemplative tone, showing the band’s evolution in both sound and perspective.

In a deliberate stand for artists’ rights and ethical media practices, No Berlin has chosen **not to release *Flow* on Spotify**. The band cites low royalty rates, the platform’s former CEO’s investments in military technology, and the running of ICE-related ads in the U.S. as reasons for this decision. Instead, the single will be available on platforms like Bandcamp and Patreon, prioritizing fair compensation and ethical distribution.

Flow will be accompanied by a private press preview on SoundCloud and a full promotional campaign handled by Snowwhite PR, including radio outreach and press features across Europe. Fans can also look forward to the band’s upcoming EP, showcasing a heavier, more introspective side of No Berlin, continuing with the same lineup that has defined their early sound.
